


## Croucher Summer Course 2018 Advances in Immunology in Health and Disease

## Registration fee for Local and Overseas Registrants (5 nights) – HK\$4,000

Registration for a shared two-bed hotel room (check in on Monday 6 August 2018, check out on Saturday 11 August 2018)

Note: Limited single rooms with higher registration fee are available upon special request and subject to approval.

Registration fee is inclusive of 5-night accommodation, course materials and all related activities during the Course. The same fee applies to all local and overseas registrants even if they opt for not staying in the accommodation arranged. Registration fee is only payable upon the confirmation of acceptance to the course.

## **Application**

We only consider a full application which includes submission of <u>ALL three items</u> to Course Secretariat by email **on or before 30 April 2018**:

- 1. a completed registration form,
- 2. an abstract of the applicant's research topic with a title and word count (word limit: 400),
- 3. an one-page CV of the applicant.

Successful applicants are required to present their research either in form of oral or poster presentations in the summer course.

## **Award for outstanding abstracts**

The CSC Committee will select 10-12 best abstracts for a 20-minute oral presentation and these applicants selected for oral presentation will be awarded for a 50% discount in registration fee. Successful applicants will be notified by **15 May 2018**.

## **Payment**

Successful applicants will be notified to pay the respective registration fee within 2 weeks upon the receipt of email notification from the Course Secretariat. Payment should be made by **31 May 2018** the latest. Payment will be made payable in Hong Kong dollars to "The University of Hong Kong" by telegraphic transfer via your local bank. Details will be given in the notification email. Late payment will be considered as forfeiting the acceptance and the place will be offered to stand-by applicants.

## **Cancellation**

Cancellation must be sent by email to Course Secretariat by **15 June 2018**, failing that, a 50% of the registration fee will be deducted as administrative fee. **No refund** will be made for cancellation after this date. Any refund will be made before 30 September 2018.
